STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Luke I. Chapman (Mr. Chapman), the licensee in this case, stipulate and agree that the unlicensed activity that occurred during the time license #47063 was in lapse status is resolved as follows:

- 1. On October 5, 2006, the division notified Mr. Chapman that his insurance bail bond license had lapsed for failure to renew.
- 2. In December of 2006, the division received application requirements necessary to reinstate Mr. Chapman's license, and the division reinstated his license effective December 26, 2006. As required by the division, a notarized statement was submitted listing whether business had been transacted while the license was in lapse status. The statement indicated that Mr. Chapman had transacted insurance between October 5, 2006 and December 21, 2006 while he was not appropriately licensed.
- 3. Prior to this instance, to the division's knowledge, Mr. Chapman has not engaged in unlicensed activity or otherwise violated the insurance code.

4. Mr. Chapman agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440(a) of
\$7,807.50, which equals the amount of commission earned for the unlicensed activity that
occurred between October 5, 2006 and December 21, 2006, with \$4,000 suspended. The
unsuspended portion of the penalty is payable within six months from the date Mr. Chapman is
notified that the director has signed the order approving this agreement.

- 5. In the event Mr. Chapman violates the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years, the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 4 will be reinstated. Mr. Chapman also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 6. By signing this agreement, Mr. Chapman understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska insurance license #47063.
- 7. Mr. Chapman understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
