STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Thad A. Langford (Mr. Langford), the licensee in this matter, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

- A. On or about April 3, 2008, the division issued an individual insurance producer license to Mr. Langford, under license number 70092 based on the application that Mr. Langford submitted to the division on or about March 17, 2008.
- B. Question 40(1) of the application asks: "Have you ever been convicted of, or are you currently charged with, committing a crime, whether or not adjudication was withheld?" To this question, Mr. Langford answered "no."
- C. When Mr. Langford's application was completed and his answers on the application did not indicate any reason not to issue him a license, the division issued the license.
- D. On June 30 2008, the division received a criminal history report that revealed a misdemeanor criminal conviction in 1992 against Mr. Langford and other charges

that was subsequently dropped through the plea negotiation process. In response to the division's request, Mr. Langford explained that he not remembered the incident when he was filling out the application. He apologized for his omission of the information on his application and provided information regarding the conviction, for which he was sentenced to 90 days jail time with 90 days suspended, \$1,000 fine with \$1,000 suspended, 20 hours of community work service, anger management counseling, and three years probation. All requirements of his conviction have been completed.

E. The director has fully reviewed Mr. Langford's file.

II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

- 1. Mr. Langford agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440(a) in the amount of \$500, with \$250 suspended. The civil penalty is payable at the time Mr. Langford is notified that the director has signed the order approving this agreement.
- 2. In the event Mr. Langford violates the insurance code or applicable regulations during the next two years, the suspended portion of the fine referenced in paragraph 1 will be reinstated. Mr. Langford also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 3. By signing this agreement, Mr. Langford understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the terms of this agreement may be grounds to revoke, further suspend, or non-renew Alaska insurance license number 70092.
- 4. Mr. Langford understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
