STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Nadine Brannon (Ms. Brannon), the licensee in this matter, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

A. In August 2010, the division conducted an investigation of allegations made by Ms. Brannon's former employer, CC Services, Inc., d/b/a Country Insurance & Financial Services (Country), regarding her behavior in four incidents.

B. The investigation found that there was not conclusive material evidence of an attempt to deceive or commit fraud in three of the incidents.

C. The investigation found that in the fourth incident Ms. Brannon acted inappropriately when she modified photographs that she submitted to Country regarding in insurance application. Her actions in this incident are violations of AS 21.27.020(b)(4) and (6) and 21.27.410(a)(1), (2), and (8) and subject Ms. Brannon to licenses suspension and civil penalties under AS 21.27.440.

1 II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

2 1. The division will suspend Ms. Brannon's license for a period of 90 days,
3 with the 90-day period suspended.

4 2. Ms. Brannon agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the
5 amount of \$2,500, with \$1,500 suspended. The civil penalty is payable at the time Ms.
6 Brannon is notified that the director has signed the order approving this agreement.

7 3. Ms. Brannon must complete at least three credit hours on the topic of
8 business insurance ethics, which may be used for the continuing education requirements to
9 maintain her license. This requirement must be completed during 2011 and, upon completion,
10 Ms. Brannon must provide a copy of the certificate of completion that confirms this
11 requirement has been met.

12 4. In the event Ms. Brannon violates Alaska insurance laws during the next
13 two years, the 90-day license suspension referenced in paragraph 1 and the suspended portion
14 of the fine referenced in paragraph 2 will be reinstated. Ms. Brannon also will be subject to any
15 and all sanctions authorized by statute, including imposition of additional penalties.

16 5. For the two-year period of this agreement, Ms. Brannon must provide
17 any future employer with a copy of the agreement before beginning to work there.

18 6. By signing this agreement, Ms. Brannon understands and agrees that any
19 failure to comply with the terms of this agreement may be grounds to revoke, further suspend,
20 or non-renew Alaska insurance license number 20250.

21 7. Ms. Brannon understands that this agreement is not binding on the
22 parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.


