STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Robert L. Tobeck (Mr. Tobeck), the licensee in this case, stipulate and agree that the unlicensed activity that occurred during the time license #60736 was in lapse status is resolved as follows:

- 1. On January 24, 2012, the division sent Mr. Tobeck notification to renewal his license. On March 9, 2012, the division notified Mr. Tobeck that his insurance producer license had lapsed for failure to renew.
- 2. On September 6, 2012, the division received application requirements necessary to reinstate Mr. Tobeck's license. The division reinstated his license effective October 4, 2012. As required by the division, Mr. Tobeck submitted a notarized statement indicating whether business had been transacted while his license was in lapse status. The statement indicated that several insurance transactions occurred between March 9, 2012 and October 3, 2012 while he was not appropriately licensed, and that he is a salaried employee and did not receive commissions on the transactions.
- 3. Prior to this instance, to the division's knowledge, Mr. Tobeck has not engaged in unlicensed activity or otherwise violated the insurance code.

1	4. Mr. Tobeck agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440(a) of
2	\$25,000 for the unlicensed activity that occurred between March 9, 2012 and October 3, 2012,
3	with \$15,000 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is payable within three
4	months from the time Mr. Tobeck is notified that the director has signed the order approving
5	this agreement.
6	5. In the event Mr. Tobeck violates Alaska's insurance laws during the next
8	two years, the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph 4 will be reinstated.
9	Mr. Tobeck also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code
10	including imposition of additional penalties.
11	6. By signing this agreement, Mr. Tobeck understands and agrees that any
12	failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or
13	not renew Alaska insurance license #60736.
14	7. Mr. Tobeck understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties
15	unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
