STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division), and Stephen L. Nims (Nims), the licensee in this case, stipulate and agree to the following:

I. BACKGROUND

A. Nims holds insurance producer license number 114334 and surplus lines broker license number 114334.

TO COMPRESSED AND THE COMPONED PROGRAMMENTS

B. Nims was the servicing agent for an Alaska insured's account on behalf of his employer Wentworth-DeAngelis, Inc. (Wentworth) from on or about January, 2011 through May, 2013.

C. On or about May, 2013, Nims left his employment with Wentworth, notified the insured of his employment change, and issued a Broker of Record without holding the statutorily-required license.

D. Due to an allegation by Nims' former employer that Nims may have transacted
business without holding the statutorily-required license, the division reviewed Nims' file and
requested additional information on this matter. In response to the division's request, Nims
confirmed that the Broker of Record was executed effective on or about May 28, 2013 which
was before Nims obtained his individual Alaska license on or about May 31, 2013.
E. As required, Nims also provided the division with a notarized statement

E. As required, Nims also provided the division with a notarized statement attesting to whether any Alaska business was transacted during the period Nims was not appropriately licensed.

F. Nims' statement indicated that one Alaska insured was covered for three years between on or about January, 2011 and May, 2013. Nims did not receive the \$22,400 earned in commissions for the 2011 and 2012 years (this was paid to Wentworth) but was paid \$8,000 in salary for the months the policies were issued. Nims' statement also indicated the Alaska insured policy issued in 2013 was under Nims' individual license and with Nims' new employer, Associated Insurance Services, Inc., and that Nims did not receive this commission but rather a salary. These transactions subject Nims to civil penalties under AS 21.27.440.

II. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. Nims agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the amount of \$13,000 for transacting business without a license between January, 2011 and May, 2013, with \$11,000 suspended. The unsuspended penalty of \$2,000 is payable at the time Nims is notified that the director has signed the order adopting this agreement.

- 2. In the event that Nims violates Alaska insurance laws during the next two years, the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph one will be reinstated. Nims also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance laws including imposition of additional penalties.
- 3. By signing this agreement, Nims understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska insurance producer license number 114334 and surplus lines broker license number 114334.
- 4. Nims understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order adopting this agreement.
