## RECISION OF ORDER REGARDING CONFIDENTIALITY OF RATE FILING FORMULA AND DATA OF BLUE CROSS OF WASHINGTON AND ALASKA

The Director of Insurance does hereby find as follows:

In August, 1988, a hearing was held before David M. Roderick, Hearing Officer, to determine whether or not the request of Blue Cross of Washington and Alaska for an order of confidentiality pertaining to a new formula for ratemaking along with the data used in the formula should be granted. Based upon the information presented at the hearing, on September 12, 1988, the Hearing Officer issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order.

The order stated:

The Director of the Division of Insurance shall withhold from public inspection the formula and data filed by Blue Cross in the subject rate filing until such time as in the opinion of the Director the release of said information would not cause unwarranted injury to Blue Cross.

The Director of the Division of Insurance shall withhold from public inspection the premium and claims data pertaining to the Anchorage School District until such time as in the opinion of the Director the above [sic] of said information would not cause unwarranted injury to Blue Cross.

On September 20, 1988, the Director, Paul A. Roller, approved the order of the Hearing Officer.

On October 7, 1993, the Director, David J. Walsh, issued Order R93-08, Clarification and Extension of Order Approved by the Director on September 20, 1988 Regarding Rate Filing Formula and Data of Blue Cross of Washington and Alaska.

The Director of Insurance hereby orders:

The above-described orders by the Director, dated September 20, 1988 and October 7, 1993, are rescinded. In accordance with AS 21.06.060, all future rate

filings made by Blue Cross of Washington and Alaska to the Alaska Division of Insurance will be available for public inspection.

This order takes effect May /3, 1994.
