**WHEREAS**, a Certificate of Authority to transact the business of insurance  
in the State of Alaska was issued to **UNITED PACIFIC INSURANCE**  
**COMPANY**, domiciled in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**WHEREAS**, the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania on May 29, 2001  
placed Reliance Insurance Company (“Reliance”) into Rehabilitation.

**WHEREAS**, the Order of Rehabilitation states that, “All references to  
“Reliance” hereinafter shall include the former subsidiaries which were

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1 previously merged into Reliance by the approval of the Commissioner: Reliance  
2 National Indemnity Company, Reliance National Insurance Company, United  
3 Pacific Insurance Company, Reliance Direct Company, Reliance Surety  
4 Company, Reliance Universal Insurance Company, United Pacific Insurance  
5 Company of New York and Reliance Insurance Company of Illinois.”

7 **WHEREAS, UNITED PACIFIC INSURANCE COMPANY** failed to  
8 properly notify the State of Alaska of the change in corporate structure which took  
9 place before the issuance of the Order of Rehabilitation.

10  
11 **WHEREAS, UNITED PACIFIC INSURANCE COMPANY** has failed to  
12 submit the 2000 annual statement due on March 1, 2001 under AS 21.09.200.

13  
14 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, pursuant to the provision of AS 21.09.140(a)  
15 that Certificate of Authority No F- 249 issued to **UNITED PACIFIC**  
16 **INSURANCE COMPANY** to transact the business of insurance in the State of  
17 Alaska shall be suspended for a period of one year unless terminated sooner as  
18 permitted by statute. Pursuant to AS 21.09.160(b), this suspension shall  
19 automatically suspend the authority of all its agents to act as agents of **UNITED**  
20 **PACIFIC INSURANCE COMPANY** in this state.

21  
22  
23 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, during the period of suspension, **UNITED**  
24 **PACIFIC INSURANCE COMPANY** shall not solicit or write any new business  
25 in Alaska, but shall file the Annual Statement, pay fees and any taxes due as  
26 provided by AS 21.09.170(b).


