STIPULATED AGREEMENT AND ORDER

The Division of Insurance (division) and Homer Insurance Center, Inc. (HICI), the licensee in this case, stipulate and agree that the unlicensed activity that occurred during the time HICI's employee Jessica E. Taylor's license #80349 was in lapse status is resolved as follows:

- 1. On November 3, 2010, the division sent Ms. Taylor a license renewal application to the address on file for her. On January 28, 2011, the division notified Ms. Taylor that her insurance producer license had lapsed for failure to renew.
- 2. On March 7, 2011, the division received application requirements necessary to reinstate Ms. Taylor's license. The division reinstated her license effective March 30, 2011. As required by the division, Ms. Taylor submitted a notarized statement indicating whether business had been transacted while her license was in lapse status. The statement indicated that several insurance transactions occurred between January 28, 2011 and February 2011, with \$1,720.20 earned in commissions, while she was not appropriately licensed. Ms. Taylor is a salaried employee and the commissions on transactions are paid to the firm, not to her.

- 3. HICI is responsible for ensuring that the firm and its employees comply with Alaska's insurance laws and is subject to penalties under AS 21.27.440 for unlicensed activity.
- 4. HICI agrees to pay a civil penalty under AS 21.27.440 in the amount of \$1,720.20, with \$720.20 suspended. The unsuspended portion of the penalty is payable at the time HICI is notified that the director has signed the order approving this agreement.
- 5. In the event HICI violates Alaska's insurance laws during the next two years, the suspended portion of the penalty referenced in paragraph 4 will be reinstated. The firm also will be subject to any and all sanctions authorized by the insurance code including imposition of additional fines or penalties.
- 6. By signing this agreement, HICI understands and agrees that any failure to comply with the conditions of this agreement will be grounds to revoke, suspend, or not renew Alaska insurance licenses #25632.
- 7. HICI understands that this agreement is not binding on the parties unless and until the director signs the order approving the agreement.
