
3. Background Question 2 reads as follows, "Has the business entity or any owner, partner, officer or director, or manager or member of a limited liability company, ever been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding, including a FINRA sanction or arbitration proceeding regarding any professional or occupational license, or registration?"
4. In the application SUPREME HEALTH lists Abul Zabair (ZUBAIR) as the compliance officer or Designated Responsible Licensed Producer (DRLP). ZUBAIR is noted to be $100 \%$ sole owner of SUPREME HEALTH.
5. The Producer Database and the Attachment Warehouse reflects administrative action was taken against SUPREME HEALTH's DRLP ZUBAIR's NPN \# 18790661 in State of Iowa in effect on June 25, 2020, State of Kansas in effect on November 3'2022, and State of New York in effect June 27, 2023. SUPREME HEALTH failed to disclose its owner's administrative actions to the Division and provided incorrect information on the application.
6. On April 10, 2023, correspondence was provided to SUPREME HEALTH informing of its failure to respond accurately to a background question of its administrative actions. The Division provided SUPREME HEALTH the opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new, complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was received.

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7. Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27 .040 (a) states that "(a) Application for a license shall be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history, experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge and belief..."
8. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is qualified under this chapter."
9. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy person."
10. Pursuant to AS 21.27.040(a), SUPREME HEALTH failed to report its complete administrative actions to the Division at initial application. Based on the above SUPREME HEALTH Insurance Producer license is hereby DENIED.

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.040(a) that SUPREME HEALTH GROUP INC application for the Insurance Producer license in Alaska under National Producer Number (NPN) \# 18791549 is DENIED for supplying inaccurate information on the application for licensure.
