

2011 Federal Fiscal Year Appropriations

On February 1, 2010, President Obama released his Administration's budget for FY2011, including \$1.416 billion for the Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS). This is an increase of \$266 million above the FY2010 enacted level.

On July 16, the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies released their version of the FY11 budget, which includes \$1.305 billion for CNCS. This is \$155 million more than last year and \$111 million below the President's request.

On July 27, the Senate Appropriations Subcommittee on Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, and Related Agencies released their version of the FY11 budget, which recommends nearly \$1.4 billion for CNCS. This is \$215.9 million above last year's level and is substantial enough to increase the number of AmeriCorps members from 87,000 to over 97,000.

An individual breakdown by program for the Senate and the House versions will be available once each of the full appropriations committees has approved the budget proposal.
