A) Nominee's accomplishments (50 points) – In narrative (max 500 words) form please describe:

- 1. Activities your nominee has done
- 2. Their accomplishments and characteristics that distinguish them from others
- 3. Community need(s) your nominee addressed
- 4. What is different as a result of your nominee's service

B) Data (35 points) – provide quantitative evidence within the narrative (max 200 words) of nominee's involvement and impact, i.e. volunteer hours, length of service, number of people served, measurable impact on community, etc.

C) Supporting documentation (15 points) – Attach supporting documents (can be scanned and emailed) such as photos, newspaper clippings and/or letter of support. Materials become the property of Serve Alaska and will not be returned.

Submission Instructions

Electronic submission is acceptable and can be completed by hitting the submit button above (which will allow you to attach additional supporting documentation to the email.) If nominator can send the complete packet electronically (nomination form with narrative and supporting documentation) in one file to <u>serve.alaska@alaska.gov</u>, it is not required to mail anything in hard copy.
