(ARE), Version 3.1, and the Building Design & Construction Systems (BD) and Schematic Design (SD) sections of the ARE, Version 4.0.

This project will be held in abeyance until a new architect is appointed to the board. The sitting architect on the board will consult with the new architect member and give a recommendation to the board at the August 2008 meeting.

#### Legislation

SB 263 passed which allows a chemical or petroleum engineer to fill the mining engineer seat on the board if a mining engineer is not available. (AS 08.48.011)

SB 263 also provides for an exemption from registration for persons designing fire detection or suppression systems and is authorized by the Department of Public Safety to design fire detection or suppressions systems. (AS 08.48.331(14)).

The board will be pursuing legislation next session to change the board composition by making the landscape architect seat on the board a permanent voting position.

#### **Continuing Education Audits**

Thirty-eight continuing education audits of land surveyors were reviewed. All were approved, except one which was approved pending verification of hours.

# **Applicant Files Reviewed**

The board reviewed 68 applications for registration and examination:

- 28 applications for registration by exam and comity were approved.
- 35 applications for registration by comity and exam were conditionally approved.
- 5 applications were found to be incomplete and will be reviewed at the August 2008 meeting upon receipt of additional documentation.

#### **Action Items - Motions**

- Motion passed authorizing a board member to research adding a special committee to look at the NCEES re-examination requirements for those that have failed the exam five times.
- Motion passed adopting a document titled "Conduct of Committees."
- Motions passed removing Legislative Liaison, B+30, Emeritus Appointment, and Accreditation from the committees.
- Motion passed authorizing the board to write a resolution in support of Daniel Walsh's continuance as a board member while on sabbatical.
- Motion passed to create a board policy to include an explanation of proposed regulation changes to accompany the public notice.
