The current *Structural I & II* exams will be offered for the last time in October 2010. Beginning April 2011, the new 16-hour Structural exam will be offered. The exam will cover two days and 8 hours each.

NCARB

The Six-month Rule that was scheduled to go into effect July 1st, 2010, for all interns has been postponed due to costs associated with updating the Prometric database.

NCARB may allow a reasonable extension of the Rolling Clock period in circumstances where completion of all divisions within the five-year period is prevented by: the birth or adoption of a child, by serious medical condition, by active duty military service or by other like causes. The requirements and instruction for submitting requests are in the Handbook for Interns and Architects.
