Conversion of the FE & FS exams to a computer-based format is at least 2 years away.

Only around 20% of engineering graduates ever obtain licensure.

As a result of the oil spill in the Gulf, the federal government is proposing rules to have a PE sign off on well casing designs. NCEES also encouraged the Bureau of Ocean Energy to incorporate licensure requirements as step toward increasing public safety.

## NCARB

The third and final phase of IDP 2.0, which was originally scheduled for January 2011, will now be implemented in Fall 2011.

NCARB may allow a reasonable extension of the Rolling Clock period in circumstances where completion of all divisions within the five-year period is prevented by: the birth or adoption of a child, by serious medical condition, by active duty military service or by other like causes. The requirements and instruction for submitting requests are in the Handbook for Interns and Architects.

The next MBE workshop will be November 4, 2010 and the MBE/MBC conference will follow on November 5-6, 2010 in New Orleans, LA.

## Fun Factoids

During WWII's London Blitz, Christopher Wren's masterpiece, St. Paul's Cathedral, built in 1710, was struck by 28 bombs. Its survival is primarily credited to St. Paul's Watch, made up of many architects, who stood guard around the cathedral and doused incendiary bombs. And, a bomb that would have destroyed the entire structure was then defused by the Royal Engineers.
