



4. 0 Architects licensed by exam between August 1 and November 1, 2016

- 30 examinees currently approved to test
- 9 have not yet scheduled their first exam
- 7/30 have passed at least 3/7 A.R.E. 4.0 Exams
- 2/30 have passed at least 4/7 A.R.E. 4.0 Exams
- 1 has passed 5/7 A.R.E. 4.0 Exams
- 5.0 launches 11/4; reduces the # of exams to 5

Since NCARB lowered the amount of hours required in the IDP, now called the **AXP – Architect Experience Program**, from 5600 hours to 3740, Alaska has only approved 3 applicants with less than 5200 hours. At this time, there is inconclusive data as to if this change reduces the time it takes to receive a license in Alaska by examination.
