Disciplinary Actions Taken

There were no disciplinary actions taken at this meeting.

Regulations Adopted

The board adopted the following regulation:

• Repeal 12 AAC 36.111, Practice of Land Surveying.

The board did not yet adopt the proposed continuing education (CE) regulations for architects, engineers and landscape architects. Based on public comment received there may be revisions to the regulations. The CE committee will finalize the regulations and the board will vote at the August 2007 meeting to adopt.

Regulations Approved for Public Notice

No new regulation projects were initiated. Pending public notice from the February 2007 meeting are the following proposed regulations:

- 12 AAC 36.196 a new section regarding field adaptation of design documents
- 12 AAC 36.055, .100 jurisprudence examination requirement

The board elected to not public notice changes to 12 AAC 36.100, .105 regarding registration by comity and examination. The board will revisit this

proposed regulation change at its August 2007 meeting.

Legislative Recommendations

- Stop Work Orders.
- Legislation to provide for expansion of petroleum or chemical engineers for the mining engineer position on the board if a mining engineer is not available.
- A new subsection in AS 08.48.331 exempting NICET certified engineers from registration.

HB 248 regarding the mining engineer seat on the board and the NICET exemption was introduced. It will be continued next session.

A bill regarding the Stop Work Order was not introduced and the board will revisit this next session.

Board Policies

No new board policies were adopted.

Other Updates

A new document is being developed for posting to the board's web site to assist architects, engineers and landscape architects with continuing education.

There is currently a document entitled "Continuing Education Guidelines for Surveyors" on the board's web site, in addition to forms for tracking and reporting CE.

Applicant Files Reviewed

The board reviewed 43 applications:

- 22 applications for registration by comity were approved.
- 4 applications for registration by examination were approved.
- 11 applications for registration by comity were conditionally approved.
- 3 applications for registration by examination were conditionally approved.
- 2 applications to sit for the FE examination were approved.
- 1 application for registration by examination was found to be incomplete and will be reviewed at the next meeting pending additional work experience verifications.

Action Items - Motions

• Motion passed to task the Additional Engineering Disciplines committee to develop regulation and statute changes to add the disciplines of structural, environmental and fire protection to those the board registers.

• Based on a recommendation from the Board Composition committee a motion passed to maintain the AELS Board as is and not pursue a separate board for architects and landscape architects.

AELS Deadlines/Exam Information

The next board meeting is tentatively scheduled for August 9-10, 2007 in Anchorage. The meeting will be held in the Atwood Building, 550 West 7th Avenue, Room 1270. The deadline for comity and examination applications is receipt in the Juneau office 10 days prior to the meeting.

NCEES exam retake requests:

In order to be approved to retake a failed NCEES exam in October 2007 written requests must be received in the Juneau office no later than August 28, 2007.

The deadline for registering for NCEES exams with ELSES is September 6, 2007. Registration opens July 1, 2007.

For all new exam applicants, applications and supporting documents must be received in the Juneau Office 10 days prior to each board meeting. **There** will be no exceptions.
