• Motion made as a second reading to create a regulation project to be voted on at the next scheduled meeting to add the following paragraph to 12 AAC 36.090(c): An application for registration as a professional engineer by comity who is currently registered as a professional engineer in a state, territory, or possession of the United States or the District of Columbia is not required to demonstrate having passed the Fundamentals of Engineering examination.

The Board decided to do more research on whether or not this was needed.

 Motion was made to table adoption of the Boar d Bylaws pending further review by the committee and Dept of Law.
