Action Items - Motions

- Motion was made to public notice changes to 12 AAC 36.064 and 12 AAC 36.065 eligibility for the surveyor examination as proposed in option 2 through February 5, 2011 and mail to all licensees. Motion passed.
- Motion was made to extend the public comment period of the General Licensure issue through February 7, 2011. Motion passed.
- Motion was made to go into Executive Session under authority of AS 44.62.310 to review applicant files. Motion passed.
- Motion was made to direct the General Licensure committee to bring back to the Board in February options for adding specific specializations to the engineering stamp. Motion failed.
