- 1. All experience must be obtained after January 30, 1999.
- 2. Successful completion of the examination is only valid for 24 months.

Mr. Maiquis asked the Board if they had any comments on the draft regulations. He also noted that the only comment he received was from Stephen Turner, who is no longer on the Board.

Vicki Ledbetter with the Appraisal Subcommittee had one suggestion. Under 12 AAC 70.130(a) to have it read, "To be certified as a real estate appraiser by examination, an applicant must pass the following examination within 24 months preceding the date of certification".

The Board agreed to send the draft regulations out for a public comment on the proposed regulations.

Upon a motion by Shaffer, seconded by Olmstead, and approved unanimously, it was:

RESOLVED to adopt the draft proposed regulations dated June 5, 2006 with the amendments.
