A recent question was posed to the board as to whether licensed chiropractic physicians are able to perform the Comprehensive Medical Examination for a private pilot's license.

Review of AS 08.20.100 (b) 6 authorizes chiropractic physicians “to perform pre-employment and workplace health examinations.” Additionally, chiropractic physicians are trained to, and perform, all procedures and tests of FAA 8700-2, Comprehensive Medical Examination Checklist (04-17) on a routine basis. Given these findings, it is the position of this board that chiropractic physicians licensed in the State of Alaska are well-qualified to perform regular Comprehensive Medical Examinations for a private pilot's license.
