Attach a letter of reference for each project attesting to your competence on the project. These project references must meet the same requirements as the letters of reference above, and may be combined in one letter and signed by the same engineer. If combined note that in the body of the letter.

The plans or other documents must be signed, sealed, and dated by the engineer in responsible charge of the project. If the engineer in responsible charge is not the applicant provide a letter, signed and stamped by the applicant, explaining the applicant's role in the preparation of the documents. This letter would be in addition to the required project reference letter. Include any necessary calculations or other supporting documentation.
