

APPLICATION CHECKLIST FOR REGISTERED OR PRACTICAL NURSE LICENSE BY ENDORSEMENT OR TEMPORARY PERMIT

In accordance with AS 08.68 and 12 AAC 44.320, the Board of Nursing authorizes that a license or a permit be issued to an applicant whose application meets the qualifications listed below. An application that does not meet the qualifications listed below must be reviewed by the Executive Administrator, a board member, or the entire board to determine if the applicant is qualified for a license by endorsement or a temporary permit.

- Temporary Permit

PART I. TEMPORARY PERMIT

An applicant who meets the following qualifications is eligible for a temporary permit:

- 1. has submitted a complete application as required in Part II(1)(A);
- 2. has submitted the permit fee and other fees as required in Part II (1)(B); (receipt #_____)
- 3. has submitted verification of a current unrestricted license to practice as a registered nurse or a practical nurse issued by another state licensing jurisdiction or Canadian province or Canadian territory;
- 4. has submitted one set of fingerprints and the processing fee as required in Part II(4); and
- 5. has no derogatory information on NURSYS database.
- 6. Employment as a nurse for 320 hours in the last 2 years.

PART II. REGISTERED OR PRACTICAL NURSE LICENSE BY ENDORSEMENT

An applicant is qualified for a license by endorsement if the applicant has met the following requirements:

- (1) documented compliance with the application requirements of 12 AAC 44.305 by submitting:
 - (A) a completed application on a form provided by the department that includes
 - i. personal identification information;
 - ii. lists all nursing licenses ever held.
 - iii. nursing education information;
 - iv. "no" answers to questions on the form dealing with the applicant's physical and mental health;
 - v. "no" answers to questions on the form dealing with criminal convictions and disciplinary questions;
 - vi. nursing related employment history for the five years immediately before the date of application;
 - vii. photograph of the applicant and the applicant's notarized signature certifying that the information on the form is correct to the best of the applicant's knowledge;
 - (B) the application fee and license by endorsement fee required in 12 AAC 02.280.
 - (2) is licensed in another state or authorized jurisdiction as a registered or practical nurse, and has submitted:
 - (A) a verification of nursing license form fully completed and signed by an authorized person representing the jurisdiction of original licensure or through Nursys: original state of licensure: _____; original date of licensure: _____;
 - (B) evidence that the applicant holds a license in another jurisdiction that is current, active, and in good standing: current state: _____; expiration date: _____.
 - (C) evidence that the licensing jurisdiction where the applicant was originally licensed required
 - (i) successful completion of a recognized nursing education program;
 - (ii) passing one of the following examinations:
 - (a) NCLEX after October 30, 1988 with a score of "pass";
 - (b) NCLEX between June 30, 1982 and October 30, 1988 with a score of 1,600 for a registered nurse candidate or a standard score of 350 for a practical nurse candidate.
 - (c) State Board Test Pool exam before July 1, 1982 with a score of 350 on each section for registered nurses and 350 on the examination for licensed practical nurses;
 - (d) another exam constructed by a licensing jurisdiction before 1953 with a score of 75 percent; or
 - (e) CNATS after July 1980, but before July 1992, with a score of 400, or before August 1980 with a score of 350 on each part;
- (3) submitted either
 - (A) a reference letter that
 - (i) is completed on a form provided by the department and signed by the applicant's past or current employer;
 - (ii) verifies the applicant has been employed in a nursing capacity for 320 hours within two years prior to application; or
 - within five years prior to application + ____ CEUs ____ Prof. Activities OR
 - (B) evidence of completion of
 - (i) completed a accredited nursing education program within past 2 years; or
 - (ii) a course of study (refresher course) predetermined by the board to be acceptable.
