We have received the pre-qualification package for [REDACTED] to receive a tax credit under the Alaska Film Production Tax Credit program. After reviewing your materials, we are pre-qualifying your project for a tax credit of up to [REDACTED]. The qualification period for this production is from [REDACTED]. Only expenses incurred in Alaska during the qualification period will be eligible for the tax credit.

This pre-qualification does not guarantee the amount of tax credit that may be earned. After we receive the final application for the tax credit and the required verification materials we will determine the actual tax credit amount. The Alaska Film Office may award a larger or smaller tax credit, depending on circumstances. As of July 1, 2011 all productions applying for the Alaska Film Production Tax Credit must have a valid Alaska Business License during the qualification period. Business Licenses and registration information are available online at the Alaska Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing (<http://www.commerce.state.ak.us/occ/>). To insure your tax credit, we strongly recommend that you procure an Alaska Business License at your earliest convenience and keep it active during the entire production.
