

Dear Mr. Paul:

Thank you for your continued interest in film production in Alaska. The Division of Economic Development received and reviewed the pre-qualification materials for the production, [REDACTED]

Based on thorough consideration by the pre-qualification review committee, we are denying this application. The decision is based on a best interest finding pursuant to AS 44.33.233 (a). At this time, it is not in the best interest of the Alaska film industry, Alaska workers, and the Alaska economy to extend a production incentive to [REDACTED]

Under 3 AAC 188.030(h) you may request a hearing regarding this denial by filing a notice of appeal as described in the regulations within 30 days of the date of this letter. The notice of appeal must be in writing and will be considered filed on the date it is received by the Film Office. The notice of appeal must clearly state your objection to the denial, the justification for the objection, and the reasons why the production should be granted a Qualification Notice under the Alaska Film Production Tax Credit program. 
