Dear Gary,

We have received your Pre Qualification application. After reviewing the synopsis of [REDACTED] we are delighted to inform you that your application is approved and you may begin your second unit work production work in Alaska. Qualifying expenses incurred after [REDACTED] may be eligible for the Alaska Film Tax Credit. Any expenses incurred on or before [REDACTED] are not eligible.

It is important to note that this approval process approves Proposal Production, Inc.'s work on [REDACTED] in Alaska, but cannot make any inferences or guarantees on the amount of tax credit that may be earned. It will not be until the final application for the tax credit is received along with proper back-up and verification that an ultimate tax credit can be determine. We acknowledge your estimate of a [REDACTED] tax credit and we approve qualifying production spending activity that could ultimately achieve a tax credit of that amount.

It is also important to note that the Alaska Film Incentive Tax Credit is still going through the regulations process. Ultimate qualifying spending criteria may differ than what can be inferred from statute. Any production company incurring expenses while the regulations are still being vetted does so under the assumed risk that expenses believed to qualify for a tax credit may not.

Thank you again for your application and we hope Alaska's majestic backdrop exceeds the expectations you are hoping for in you second unit shots of [REDACTED]
