NOTICE

C T Group, Inc. / Universal Pacific Insurance

The State of Alaska, Division of Insurance has received information that a company named CT Group, Inc., based in Houston, Texas has been soliciting liquor industry business establishments in Alaska a liability insurance product. A review of the State of Alaska, Division of Insurance records failed to reflect CT Group, Inc. as being licensed to transact the business of insurance in this state. Furthermore, the insurance agency involved, G. Morgan Insurance Agency and/or Gilbert Scott Morgan in Houston, Texas are not licensed.

A review of the information indicated that the insurance carrier was Universal Pacific Insurance Company, has not been issued a Certificate of Authority to transact business in the State of Alaska. An Internet search of Universal Pacific Insurance Company found that this insurance company is domiciled in the "Sovereign State of Rotuma." Rotuma is one of the islands in the South Pacific and is referred to as Rotuma, Fiji. The parent company for Universal Pacific Insurance Company is IBA Ltd., which is domiciled in Belize with an address and telephone number in Mexico.

The State of Alaska, Division of Insurance advises that CT Group, Inc., G. Morgan Insurance Agency, Gilbert Scott Morgan, and Universal Pacific Insurance Company are not authorized to transact the business of insurance in this state.
