ACCUSATION & ORDER OF REVOCATION

1. On or about May 27th, 2022, **MATTHEW WESLEY CHAMBERS (CHAMBERS)**, domiciled in the State of Louisiana applied for Insurance Adjuster License with the Alaska Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development, Division of Insurance (Division) with Property lines of authority.
2. On June 13th, 2022, the Division issued **CHAMBERS** license number 3001984314. This license authorized **CHAMBERS** to transact insurance business in the State of Alaska which expires on February 29th, of even numbered years.
3. On November 30th, 2022, the Division received correspondence from the National Insurance Producer Registry (NIPR) with an attached transaction log from indicating **CHAMBERS** license application payment was returned as insufficient

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funds (NSF). The unsettled payment of \$75 for State licensing fee and \$5.60 for transaction fee totaling \$80.60 in unpaid license fees.

4. On December 5th, 2022, the Division sent notice to **CHAMBERS** informing him of his unpaid license fees. **CHAMBERS** was given until December 30th, 2022. In the same notice **CHAMBERS** was informed failure to pay could result in a referral to the Enforcement Unit for administrative action. No payment was received by the Division.
5. Alaska Statutes (AS) 21.27.410 (a)(8) dictates, “the conduct of affairs under a license if the licensee exhibits conduct considered by the director to reflect incompetence or untrustworthiness, or to be a source of potential injury and loss to the public;”
6. Alaska Statute (AS) 21.27.010(a) also states in part that “...a person may not act as or represent to be an insurance producer, managing general agent, or surplus lines broker in this state or relative to a subject resident, located, or to be performed in this state unless licensed under this chapter.”
7. Further, AS 21.27.440(a) provides that “in addition to any other penalties. provided by law, a person that the director of the division (director) determines under AS 21.06.170-21.06.240 has violated the provisions of this chapter is subject to (1) a civil penalty equal to the compensation promised, paid, or to be paid, directly or indirectly, to a person in regard to each violation; (2) either a civil penalty of not more than \$10,000 for each violation or a civil penalty of not more than \$25,000 for each violation if the director determines that the person

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willfully violated the provisions of this chapter; and (3) denial, nonrenewal,
suspension, or revocation of a license.”

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.440, that
CHAMBERS’s Insurance Adjuster license 3001984314 is REVOKED for a period of
one year.
