ACCUSATION AND FINAL ORDER

Lori Wing-Heier, Director of the Division of Insurance (Division), Department of
Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), State of Alaska, states
the issues on which the accusation is based as follows:

1. On November 27, 2023, **JOHN JAMES POWTER (POWTER)**,
domiciled in the State of Texas applied for an Insurance Producer license
with the Division to conduct insurance business in the State of Alaska.
2. Upon review of the application, **POWTER** responded negatively to
background question 2, indicating no administrative actions to report to
the State of Alaska.

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- 1 3. The Producer Database and the Attachment Warehouse reflects
2 administrative actions were taken against **POWTER** in the State of
3 Wisconsin in effect November 2, 2000, in the State of Maine in effect
4 November 16, 2000, and in the State of Indiana in effect October 2, 2008.
5 **POWTER** failed to disclose his administrative actions to the Division and
6 provided inaccurate information on his application.

- 8 4. On November 30, 2023, correspondence was provided to **POWTER**
9 informing of his failure to respond accurately to a background question
10 regarding administrative actions. The Division provided **POWTER** the
11 opportunity to voluntarily withdraw the application and provide a new,
12 complete, and accurate application within 30 days. No response was
13 received.

- 15 5. Alaska Statute 21.27.040(a) states that “(a) Application for a license shall
16 be made to the director upon forms prescribed by the director. As a part of
17 or in connection with the application, the applicant shall furnish
18 information concerning the applicant's identity, personal history,
19 experience, business record, purposes, and other pertinent facts that the
20 director may reasonably require. The applicant shall declare, subject to
21 penalty of denial, nonrenewal, suspension, or revocation of a license
22 issued by the director, that the statements made in or in connection with
23 the application are true, correct, and complete to the best of the applicant's
24 knowledge and belief...”
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6. AS 21.27.020(a) provides: "For the protection of the people of this state, the director may not issue or renew a license except in compliance with this chapter and not issue a license to a person, or to be exercised by a person, found by the director to be untrustworthy, incompetent, or who has not established to the satisfaction of the director that the person is qualified under this chapter."

7. AS 21.27.020(b)(4) provides: "To qualify for issuance or renewal of an individual license, an applicant or licensee shall (4) be a trustworthy person."

8. Pursuant to AS 21.27.040(a), **POWTER** provided inaccurate information at the time of application. Based on the above **POWTER's** Insurance Producer license application is hereby DENIED.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, under the provisions of AS 21.27.040(a) that **JOHN JAMES POWTER** application for the Insurance Producer license in Alaska under National Producer Number (NPN) # 1006023 is DENIED for supplying inaccurate information on the application for licensure.
